

2024/2025 Academic Year Food Industry Sales Association of Northern CA Scholarship Application

This scholarship award for higher education is given to students who exhibit leadership in school, community activities and demonstrate superior scholastic achievement.

The Food Industry Sales Association plans to award multiple scholarships for the 2024-2025 academic school year in the amount of \$3,000 with one scholarship of \$4,000 going to the top applicant. Prospective applicants may apply if attending an undergraduate/graduate course of study in Fall 2024/2025, at an accredited two-or-four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. This includes those students currently enrolled in an undergraduate course of study and has one or more years of school remaining.

OFFICIAL RULES

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must work for or be an immediate family member of a company that is a current member of the Food Industry Sales Association of Northern California. Employees or immediate family members of Food Retailer/Wholesalers that are headquartered in the Northern California trade area also qualify. (Immediate family members include son, daughter, brother, sister, mother, father, niece, nephew, or grandparents, including in-law thereof.)

Applicants must complete the application form in its entirety and email to NorthernCAFISA@gmail.com by the entry deadline, May 1, 2024.

All applicants will be evaluated based on 5 Criteria:

- Scholastic Achievement
- Leadership in Community & School
- Essay
- Clear Statement Education/Career Goals
- Financial Need

The FISA scholarship committee will have the sole responsibility for the selection of recipients and its decision will be final.

Recipients will be notified with a phone call and follow up email. All Federal, State, and local laws and regulations apply. Recipients shall be responsible for any and all taxes. Recipients will be required to sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility/Release of Liability. Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name and/or likeness for purposes of

advertising and promotion and agreement to attend a local awards ceremony at the FISA expense. Transfer of the scholarship is not permitted. The award will be paid directly to the registrar at the recipient's school after verification of enrollment. The Funds must be used within a 12-month period from the date announced, exceptions must have FISA board approval and must be in writing.
